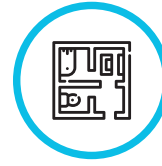

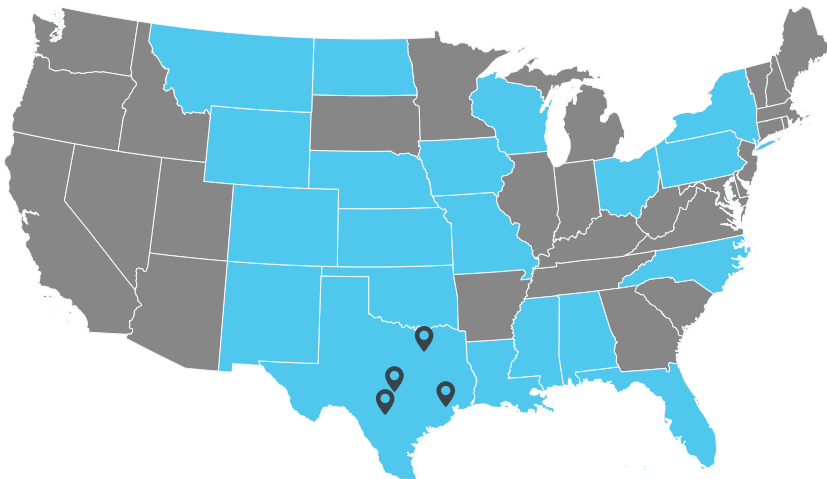

RESTAURANT | EVENT SPACE

Buffalo Bayou Brewing's new location is a 28,258 square-foot, 3-story brewery, that features a taproom, restaurant, patio, private event space and party deck. The brewery, completed in 2019, is located adjacent to The Silos at Sawyer Yards in the Washington Avenue Arts District. On the first floor there is a beer garden and views into the production area while the second floor features over 40 taps, restaurant space and a patio. There is a full downtown Houston skyline view with a rooftop bar and event space on the third floor.

8th Wonder Distillery, located across the street from 8th Wonder Brewery, takes similar design cues from the original brewery to tie them together. Industrial design cues are shown throughout the space with exposed brick, wood, metal, and concrete. Barrels were used as tables, wooden chairs with grass texture, and subway tile along the back wall were choices throughout the distillery.

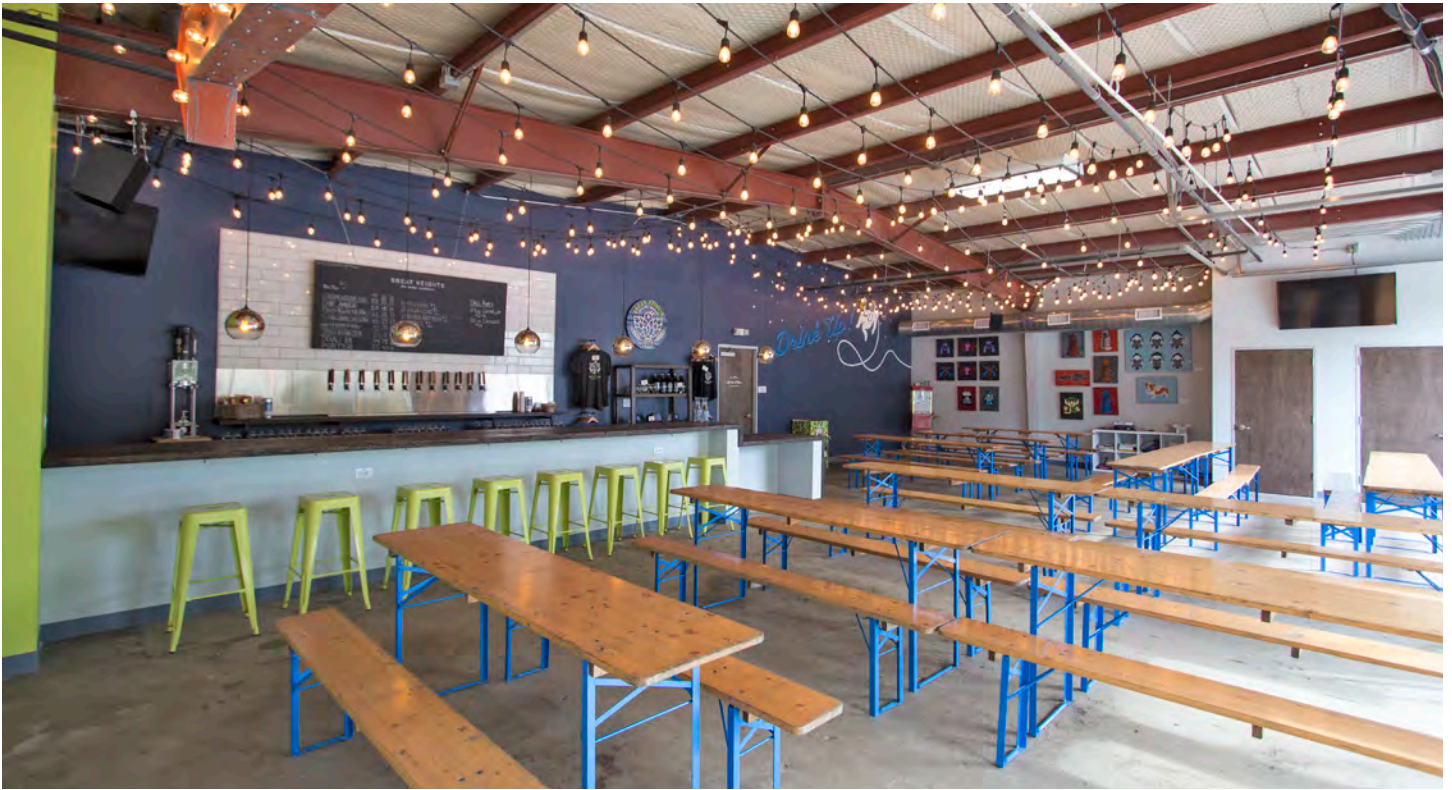

Located in the growing Greater Heights neighborhood of Houston and completed in 2017, Great Heights Brewing Co. features an airy taproom, outside patio and indoor event space next to the brewery production floor. The taproom has an overall simplistic design but with the use of warm lighting, large windows and bright color accents, we were able to create an inviting new neighborhood locale.

TRUE ANOMALY BREWING

ADAPTIVE REUSE | INTERIOR FINISH | EVENT SPACE

True Anomaly started as friends brewing in their garage, all had full-time jobs as rocket scientists, space-suit developers, and mission managers with NASA. They were ready to take it to the next level and asked us to help them convert an existing metal building in Houston's booming Eado neighborhood into a brewery and tap room. The overall design included modern finishes and colors, large windows, and stacked brite tanks behind the bar as a focal point of the tap room. Pops of bright blue and green are used throughout the design, along with, wooden accents. Glass garage doors allow an indoor-outdoor flow. There is a large event room in the back with windows that allow a view through the taproom. Along the outside back of the metal building, there is a graffiti wall with a space theme and the main piece of graffiti saying "Houston we have lift off".

Previously utilized as a night club, Platypus Brewing's renovation transformed the facility into a full-service brewery and taproom including a commercial kitchen. The space includes a special event mezzanine where patrons can get close up views of the malt handling conveyor and see the brewing process from start to finish. The outdoor patio is designed for customers to enjoy this brewery's unique Australian spin on craft brewing while taking in the exciting night life of the Washington corridor.

Urban South Brewery is a well known and popular brewery in New Orleans, Louisiana. With their success in NOLA, they decided to open a secondary location in Houston's Art District of Sawyer Yards with a 10-barrel brewhouse and canning line. This brewery includes a large taproom, brewhouse, large patio and beer garden, 2 private meeting rooms, and event space. The design of the space still holds onto their New Orleans roots with a large, colorful graffiti wall, pops of bright colors, and eclectic roller skates hanging from the ceiling as lighting.

Completed in 2014, Spindletap Brewery consisted of a remodel of an existing building for the brewery and taproom. The brewery's design was influenced from the major oil discovery at Spindletop Hill outside of Beaumont, Texas in 1901 which is where Spindletap's name came from. Concrete flooring, brick and wood were used throughout the interior, while windows line the back wall to create a view into the brewery area.
