### ADAPTIVE REUSE

8200 Washington consists of the renovation of an existing two-story pre-engineered metal building to be used as a mixed use retail development called Railway Heights. This project will have a 38,000-square-foot warehouse filled with vendors selling food, art, jewelry and more. Also, there are plans for a half-acre of green space and a 13,000-square-foot beer garden. Railway Heights Market is expected to open in 2019.

This 13,088 SF, mixed-use building will be a two story retail center in the Midtown area of Houston, Texas. The second floor will consist of a rheumatology medical office and general office space for a future tenant while the first floor will have retail/restaurant space. A modern design is used throughout this project from the skirt glass windows to horizontal wood slates on the side of the building. 

Bravery Chef Hall is a modern food hall which features 5 chef stations with seating for 20-30 guests per station as well as community style seating in the surrounding space. The design allows for multiple styles of dining where patrons can either sit at the chef's station or a community style seating area. In addition to the 5 stations, there will also be two cocktail bars, a large wine bar, a coffee lounge and a back patio with ample seating.

Broken Barrel is a wine bar and restaurant in the Hughes Landing Development located in The Woodlands. 

Buffalo Bayou Brewing's new location is a 28,258 square-foot, 3-story brewery, that features a taproom, restaurant, patio, private event space and party deck. The brewery, completed in 2019, is located adjacent to The Silos at Sawyer Yards in the Washington Avenue Arts District. On the first floor there is a beer garden and views into the production area while the second floor features over 40 taps, restaurant space and a patio. There is a full downtown Houston skyline view with a rooftop bar and event space on the third floor.

Whiskey River consisted of a ground-up, single-story, pre-engineered metal building dancehall, bar and grill. The owners wanted to maintain the western dance hall aesthetic to be consistent with their other locations, therefore, wood siding, raw concrete floors, and rustic interior furnishings and fixtures were chosen. The exterior utilizes blue and brown with wood accents. A xeriscape landscape design of crushed granite and bull rocks kept with the western aesthetic while also helping conserve water and take a green initative.






