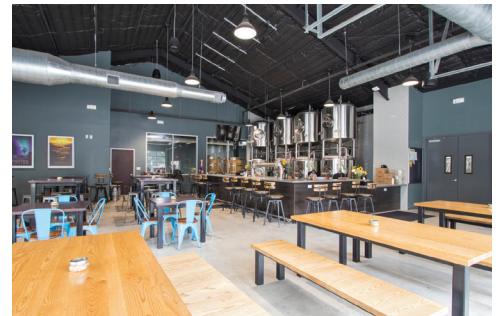

The overall design included modern finishes and colors, large windows, and stacked brite tanks behind the bar as a focal point of the tap room. Pops of bright blue and green are used throughout the design, along with, wooden accents. Glass garage doors allow an indoor-outdoor flow. There is a large event room in the back with windows that allow a view through the taproom. Along the outside back of the metal building, there is a graffiti wall with a space theme and the main piece of graffiti saying "Houston we have lift off."

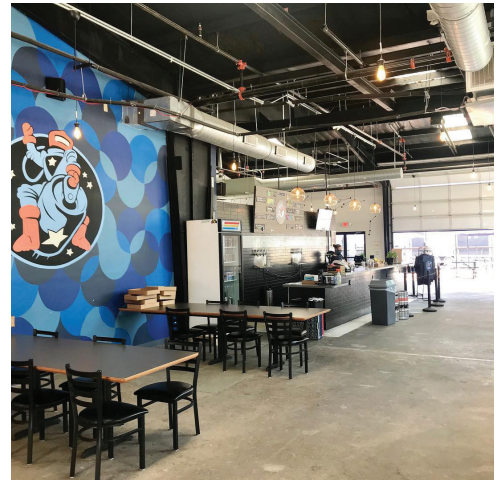

Method Architecture began working with Karbach Brewing Company in 2013 for the design of their first brewhouse and restaurant. Karbach expanded their brewhouse to include an on-site packaging and distribution facility. In 2016, Karbach Brewing Company was acquired by Anheuser-Busch InBev. Method has continued to support the growing brewery through multi-phase expansions and renovations to their facilities across the growing campus in Northwest Houston.

Phase 1: Brewhouse & Restaurant

This 22,040 SF, 2-story brewhouse and restaurant is comprised of a mix of PEMB and steel construction. With a full kitchen, two event spaces, a restaurant and bar with indoor and outdoor seating, this versatile and functional space features a state-of-the-art brewhouse and fermentation system, as well as a restaurant and tap room with views into the brewhouse.



As part of the Karbach Brewing Company Complex in Houston, Texas, this facility, completed in 2017, serves as the canning and storage warehouse as well as offices for the brewery. Located adjacent to the brewery and taproom, this 2-story building utilizes form liner and tilt-wall panel construction to simulate metal panel which was used in the brewhouse and restaurant project completed in 2015.

Phase 2: Packaging Hall

Completed in 2017, this 50,351 SF expansion facility serves as the canning and storage warehouse as well as offices for the brewery. Located adjacent to the brewery and taproom, this 2-story building utilizes form liner and tilt-wall panel construction to simulate metal panel to provide a cohesive design across the campus.

This project was awarded a 2018 Tilt-Up Concrete Achievement Award by the Tilt-Up Concrete Association for it's creative use of tilt-wall and form-liners to create a different aesthetic.

Phase 3: Bunker Expansions & Misc Renovations

To address the need for growth within their space, our team worked with Karbach through two bunker expansions totaling 4,278 SF and a handful of miscellaneous renovation and improvement projects including a boiler room addition, parking lot expansion and interior renovations.

Completed in 2014, Spindletap Brewery consisted of a remodel of an existing building for the brewery and taproom. The brewery's design was influenced from the major oil discovery at Spindletop Hill outside of Beaumont, Texas in 1901 which is where Spindletap's name came from. 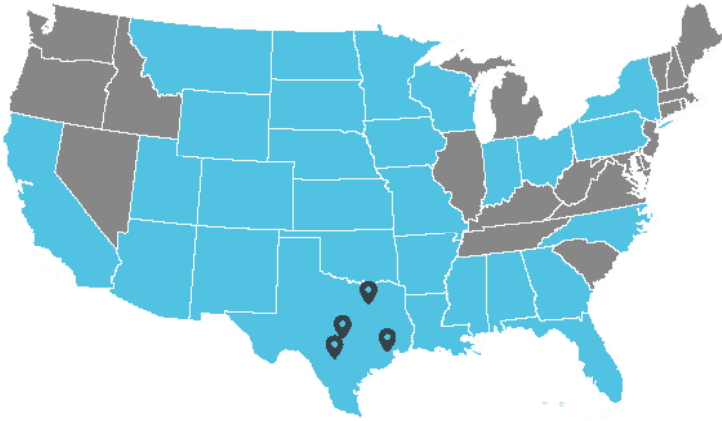
